Keeping up your Home

Residents should check their home on a regular basis to help maintain the condition and appearance of their home. By maintaining your property, you help protect the value of your home long term.

We should all remember that living in a good neighborhood is not a right; it is a responsibility for all of us to do our part.

The following check list will prove useful in maintaining your home and identifying those small areas that are often overlooked.



Property Maintenance Checklist

Are your Exterior Walls:

- in good repair, free of holes or decay
- without peeling paint
- properly maintained with painted soffits & fascia
- free of missing bricks or mortar

Is your Roof:

- free of leaks,
- with shingles in good condition-not worn or missing
- with gutters and downspouts in good repair and free of obstructions

Are your Doors (including garage):

- properly maintained, weather-tight
- secured hinges and locks

Is your Foundation:

- structurally sound
- free of holes or cracks

Are your Windows and Screens:

- weather-tight, properly glazed glass and free of cracks or holes
- in sound condition, operable

Are your House Numbers:

- visible from the street and alley
- in numerals (1, 2, 3 etc.) only
