The City of Owasso Refuse Division is transitioning to a fully automated refuse collection system. The reason for this transition is to improve efficiency, reduce injuries and assist in cost control of the refuse collection service. In a fully automated collection system, the driver remains in the refuse vehicle and a hydraulically controlled arm reaches out to grasp and tip the refuse container. With automated collection refuse container placement becomes a critical component of the refuse collection operation.



Basic guidelines for the refuse collection service:

- 1. Only City of Owasso issued containers will be collected.
- 2. Containers should placed curbside before 7 AM on collection day.
- 3. The container weight limit is 200 LBS.
- 4. All trash must be bagged; in or out of the container to prevent litter and blowing trash.
- 5. **Please <u>do not</u> make any container modifications**. Modifications, including lid straps, may inhibit proper lid opening and cause damage during tipping.
- 6. **Non-collectable Items:** Car batteries, toxic waste or liquids, motor oil, paint, tires, medical waste, cardboard, boxes, construction debris including; lumber, bricks, dirt, stones, sheet rock, carpet, furniture, appliances, or metal waste.
 - Cardboard, plastics, glass, paper and other recyclables may be deposited at the Recycle Center.

Container placement guidelines:

- 1. The container should be placed on level ground.
- 2. The container should be placed within 4' of curb or street edge.
- 3. The container should be placed with a 4' clearance from any and all obstructions including: vehicles, mailboxes, other containers, trees and bushes, landscape features and utility poles.
- 4. The container should be placed with a 10' clearance from any overhead obstructions: trees and wires.
- 5. The container should be placed with the serial # or lid opening toward the street.
- 6. The container lid must completely close.
- 7. Nothing should be placed on top of the container lid.

Collection day guidelines:

- 1. Please <u>remove vehicles</u> and other obstructions off the street on collection day, including basketball goals.
- 2. In Cul-de-Sacs you may need to place the container in the street gutter or front of the driveway.
