☐ Test smoke/carbon monoxide detectors
\square Test garage door auto-reverse feature
☐ Run water and flush toilets in unused spaces
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Biannually

☐ Give your house a deep clean
☐ Vacuum your refrigerator coils

\square Test your electricity to the extent that you can
\square Tighten any handles, knobs, racks, etc.
