The City of Tulsa, in cooperation with the Metropolitan Environmental Trust (M.E.T.), is hosting a special household pollutant collection event. The attached flyer describes the event and includes contacts to obtain more information about the March 30th event.

The City of Tulsa's Household Pollutant Permanent Collection Facility will hold a special pollutant collection event on **March 30th from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm at 4502 S. Galveston Ave. Tulsa, OK.** Special items being accepted at this event only are: **tires, e-waste, medications and ammunition.** This in addition to the normally accepted Items listed below. For this event, citizens will not need to make an appointment as normally required. The disposal of the special items will only be available to Tulsans and M.e.t. member communities. Residents of M.E.T communities may dispose of up to 60 pounds for free (tires, e-waste, medication and ammunition not included in weight limit) but will be charged for anything over that amount for normally accepted items.
