



Storm Shelter Registration



The reality of living in Oklahoma is that during certain times of the year, although rare, tornados and severe weather create potential risks for residents. You've taken the first step for your family's safety by installing a storm shelter. Registering your storm shelter is another important step in case it is necessary for emergency responders to locate residents after a tornadic or other emergency event.

The City's Storm Shelter Registration is as simple as clicking and filling in a few pieces of pertinent information for emergency response teams. Once you complete the registration, this information will only be visible to our emergency responders. We value your privacy and will not share any of this information other than for search and rescue operations, which may include training purposes.

Registering Your Shelter From A Computer

To register your shelter, visit the City's Public GIS page at <https://cityofowasso.com/404/GIS-Mapping> and click the link for the **GIS Website**. This will give you access to the public viewer of the City's Geographic Information System.

To access the Storm Shelter Registration form, click the plus symbol on the tool bar and fill in the information requested. Then click Save. That's all that is needed to helping us locate you and your family in an emergency response event.



Registering Your Shelter From A Mobile Device

Registering your Storm Shelter from a mobile phone or tablet is just as easy as on your computer. Use the QR code below to access the public GIS viewer, then tap the plus symbol, fill out the form and tap Save. It may be necessary to switch to Landscape Mode on your device to see the form.
